# **BOM June: Attic Window- Parrots**

(Un-Finished Block size 8 1/2" x 9 ½ ")

## Please remember to bring your Blocks to the <u>JUNE</u> meeting.

*Kit Contents:* Directions. Pre-cut fabric to make two blocks. Two each of: parrot centers 6 ½ "x 6"; dark green bottoms 6 " x 2 ½ "; yellow side piece 7 ½" x 2 ½ "; dark green squares 2 ½ " x 2 ½ "; black right side sashing 7 ½ " x 1 ½ " Note: For additional directions or if you are new to attic windows or to this version, check out the Missouri Star Quilt company Tutorial at: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=H-vzI0Jp3ak

### **Cutting Tips and Directions.**

*Blocks:* Fabric is pre-cut. Press out wrinkles.

### **Sewing Tips and Directions**

*Tip 1*: Trim any excess after sewing.

*Tip* 2: Check the direction of the diagonal on the left side of the window frame twice.

*Tip 3*: Sew from bottom up when adding left window frame.

#### For each block:

- 1. Sew on the dark green bottom strip first. Press open
- 2. Sew the black sashing strip to the right side of the block. Press open.
- 3. Prepare the left side of the window frame strip by:
  - a. Place the 2½ square over the bottom of the yellow strip.
  - b. Make a finger press diagonal fold in the square.
  - c. Check that the diagonal is going in the correct direction. That is the corner is at the corner of the parrot block. (See Picture)
- 4. Sew diagonal seam. Press open. Trim excess fabric.
- 5. Pin to match edges. Sew left side window frame to block. Press open
