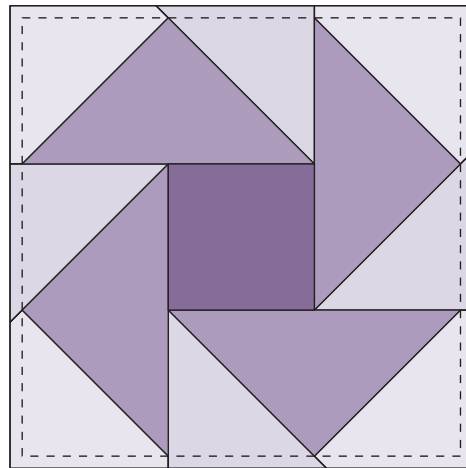


Finished Block Size = 9" x 9"  
Block Size = 9 1/2" x 9 1/2"

**Cutting:**

- Cut 1 square 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" in dark
- Cut 4 rectangles 6 1/2" x 3 1/2" in medium
- Cut 8 squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" in light

**Sewing:**

- Mark the wrong side of all 8 light triangles diagonally from corner to corner.
- Sew one light square to medium rectangle matching corner and edges. **(A)**
- Flip the corner back to make sure it matches the corner of the medium rectangle.
- If not, resew. If it does, trim the back of the rectangle and square off leaving a 1/4" seam. **(B)**
- Press to the light.
- Repeat on the other side of the rectangle. **(C)**
- Check and trim as before.
- Make 4 units. **(D)**
- This gets tricky, so be careful.
- Sew a geese unit to the center dark square HALF WAY. See red line. Backstitch. **(E)**
- Press to the center square.
- Continue adding geese units around the center square as numbered in drawing.
- After the fourth unit is sewn, close up the partial seam to finish.
- Check that the block measures 9 1/2" x 9 1/2".
