

## MAY Block of the Month Part Three: Paper Piecing.

Our May Pattern is an unfinished  $8\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$  block made up of four components, two like our March BOM and two with 4 triangles.

- The BOM team is supplying fabric and the paper templates. Included here.
- The fabric in the kit provides the center squares for two (2)  $8\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$  unfinished blocks. (Four  $3\frac{1}{2}''$  by  $3\frac{1}{2}''$  squares of the green fern fabric)
- If you saved fabric from March's BOM, you may make more blocks.
- Each block will need 2 paper patterns.
- Make enough copies of the paper pattern for each block.

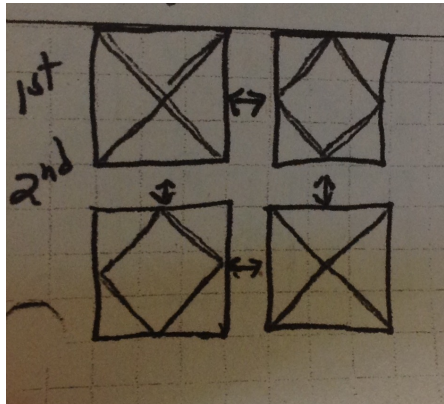
Part One- Square A. Two components are the squared diamond from March and April.

1. Use the kit fabric for your center square.
2. Use fabric from your stash to add the outside triangles.
3. For each component, sew, and press the triangles.
4. Square up the four sub-pieces to  $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$  squares.

Part Two - Square B - Two components are made from scrap fabric.

1. Cut a triangle template measuring  $3\frac{3}{4}''$  by  $3\frac{3}{4}''$  by  $5\frac{1}{2}''$
2. Cut eight (8) triangles.
3. Sew as shown in picture.

Finish the Block by sewing the four squares together to make an  $8\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$  unfinished block.
